Community Clubhouse: The clubhouse is open and available for rental! All clubhouse reservations must be made online. Fees to rent the clubhouse are as follows: \$100 for the first 4 hours, \$25 for each additional hour; \$500 refundable deposit.

2021 Pool Season: As a reminder, the pools are now on modified operational hours, to coincide with the return to school. The pools are open Monday through Thursday from 4:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.; Friday from 4:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m.; Saturday from 10:00 a.m. – 9:00 p.m.; and Sunday from 10:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m. The pools will close for the season on Monday, September 6th. Wishing everyone a wonderful end to the summer!

Unvaccinated individuals over the age of 11 are still encouraged to wear masks while using the indoor restrooms at the pools or while using the clubhouse. Please note that operational procedures for the pools and clubhouse are subject to change based on public health guidelines in effect at any time.
