Pursuant to the Public Health Order issued by the Tri-County Health Department on November 23, 2021, masking is now required in all public indoor spaces in Arapahoe County, regardless of vaccination status. All residents, guests, and staff aged two (2) years and older must wear a face covering while inside at the clubhouse, through at least January 2, 2022, as described in the Public Health Order.

<u>Authority Parking Areas</u>: As a friendly reminder, the Authority has parking regulations in place that regulate the time and manner in which motor vehicles can be parked in the Authority's parking areas. Authority parking areas are reserved solely for guests for a period of 24 hours or less. Owners, residents, and renters are not permitted to park in any Authority parking areas.
